This program is a prepaid service sponsored by Acadia Pharmaceuticals Inc. There is no additional cost to you. The recycling service is only available in the United States, excluding Alaska, Hawaii, and U.S. territories.

Returning your packaging materials for recycling



Drop off at a local UPS store or Access Point[®]

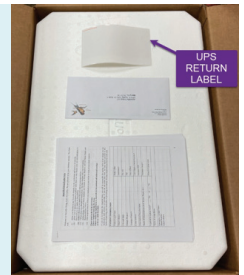

Please note you can also choose to recycle or dispose of your packaging materials by following local guidelines for the city/town you live in.

Preparing the packaging materials for return



Each month, AnovoRx ships your medicine directly to your door. You will receive a temperature-protective cooler inside your container that includes your medicine for the month, supplies, and a prepaid UPS return label.



When you receive your shipment, open your packaging container. Remove medicine, supplies, and the prepaid UPS return label that will be inside.



Immediately store your DAYBUE in an upright position refrigerated at 2°C to 8°C (36°F to 46°F). Do not freeze.



Seal your outer packaging container with plastic or nylon tape at least two inches wide. UPS does not allow the use of duct tape.



Attach the enclosed prepaid UPS return label to the outside of the packaging container. Make sure to remove or cover the old shipping label on the packaging container.

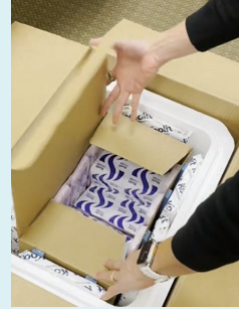
All packaging materials are accepted. All materials, except ice packs, will be recycled.



If I choose to utilize the Recycling Service, what can I include in my packaging container?

You can include all packaging materials:

- All cardboard boxes in the shipment
- Styrofoam cooler
- Bubble wrap or other materials used in shipping
- Ice packs—these will not be recycled but we will dispose of them



Make sure your container is empty of all medicine and supplies.

What happens to the materials?

Acadia's recycling partner will recycle all cardboard, styrofoam, bubble wrap or other materials used in shipping. We will accept ice packs but they will not be recycled.
